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| 2. | <p>Minutes of the Meeting – 25 January 2018</p> <p>The Yammer group has been shut down by NHS E for governance reasons. PH/SB to develop website and explore possibility of a forum in private login area.</p> <p>PH is attending Lung NCG next month in line with promotion of links with primary/secondary care</p> | |
| 3. | <p>“C The Signs” - Bea Bakshi</p> <p>C The Signs is only primary care diagnostic tool that uses NICE NG12 guidelines and is endorsed by NICE.</p> <p>CCG’s are purchasing licences for their footprint. In the three EoE CCG’s (Luton, Norwich & Herts Valleys) there is up to a 70% uptake in GP practices. CCG Log In page ideal platform for distributing information to GP’s.</p> <p>Some issues with integration with practice software being resolved.</p> <p>Full app not been operational long enough for proper evaluation. Support from NHS E for development of Patient Symptom app as well.</p> | |
| 4. | <p>28 Day to Diagnosis Pilot</p> <p>Lessons learned so far include need for robust and efficient administration and direct access to diagnostics essential if target of standard to be achieved by 2020.</p> | |
| 5. | <p>PSA Testing Guidelines</p> <p>PH presented suggested guidelines for PSA testing in primary care but no consensus reached, so not to be widely disseminated at present</p> <p>Action –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Distribute CRUK leaflet on PSA testing numbers - Distribute CRUK infographic on PSA result interpretation - Distribute edited guidelines - Distribute PHE leaflet on advice to GP’s on PSA testing for over 50’s - Distribute CRUK Patient prostate leaflet - PH to liaise with Urology NCG | KR/PH |
| 6. | <p>FIT Testing</p> <p>PH clarified that in Suffolk & N E Essex, FIT testing is initially to be used as a diagnostic test for symptomatic patients not suited for a 2WW referral as per NG30.</p> <p>STP roll out experiencing some difficulties in reporting back of test results where Nottingham Pathology is the preferred pathology provider due to IT issues.</p> <p>The effects locally on colonoscopy rates will need to be monitored in addition to the effects reported on the Scotland trials last meeting.</p> <p>PH – needs to be regular shared learning between primary care across the STP’s due to the roll out taking place as a separate project in each STP. Secondary care can be involved in planned meetings and telecoms, but usage in secondary care a separate issue. Existing 2WW colo-rectal pathways need to continue.</p> | |
| 7. | <p>Practice Cancer Update Packs</p> <p>AY introduced the Practice packs co-produced by MacMillan and CRUK. Shows detailed performance data by practice across a given geography. Data taken from Fingertips, presented to allow CCG’s to improve performance across included metrics.</p> <p>SB announced the Cancer Alliance will be producing a data pack showing performance metrics down to practice and tumour site level. Currently at draft stage.</p> | |

| 8. | <p>CRUK Pharmacist Training</p> <p>CRUK have launched a bespoke pharmacist training programme to increase cancer awareness. DR reported that 130+ have already attended the courses.</p> <p>Action –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Circulate flyer and registration details with of CRUK Pharmacy Training | KR |
| 9. | <p>STP Updates</p> <p>Norfolk & Waveney – Linda Hunter presented Cancer Transformation Plans for the STP</p> <p>Cambridge & Peterborough – The “masterclasses” continue to be well attended and similar schemes are being started elsewhere.</p> <p>Suffolk & N E Essex – A screening sub-group with PHE is identifying good/functional/ dysfunctional GP practices to target training and encouragement to improve screening.</p> <p>Herts & W Essex – location on the periphery of London, with many pathways shared with London, are making performance figures difficult to present accurately</p> <p>Mid & S Essex – Pathway reviews are progressing well. FIT roll out experiencing issues with Nottingham Pathology labs.</p> <p>Chrissie Marshall – Patients tend to be well represented on regional and general groups and boards, but encouragement needed to find site-specific representatives.</p> | |
| 10. | <p>Cancer Care Reviews</p> <p>Recovery pathway dependant on cancer care Reviews, and they vary in content across the region. Planned “workshop” deferred to next meeting due to pressures of time.</p> <p>Action –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All review templates to be sent to kevin.roos@nhs.net for review and shared learning possibly via a “learn and share” event. | ALL |
